Standards and Expectations

The Music Centre wishes to have an atmosphere of courtesy and co-operation. Our ethos is one of learning and teaching in a safe, healthy, and supportive environment. By adhering to the following rules, you will help to achieve this aim.

- Students must always treat everyone in the College with courtesy and respect.
- All equipment, rooms and common areas must be used in a respectful manner. Damage or destruction of any kind will not be tolerated.
- All students must attend all classes on time out of respect for other students and staff.
- Students must bring all required books, instruments and material required for class.
- Students must practice their instrumental skills and complete all homework assigned to them.
- Movement throughout the College building is to be quiet and orderly and, in a manner, appropriate to a busy learning environment catering for children and adults.
- Music students are not permitted in the building unless attending classes or other Music Centre activities.

These rules apply to all internal and external activities, trips etc. taking place under the control of the College.

You are requested to notify the Music Office of any issues – educational or health – that might interfere with or otherwise impair student learning or attendance.

Music Centre Activities

City of Dublin ETB Music Centre, Kylemore College has a range of musical activities which link in and are integral to the educational ethos of the College. These include participation in the orchestras, ensembles and groups which represent the Music Centre at concerts and events. They also include solo performances at High Achiever and other events. The Music Centre and its staff encourage and expect all students to participate in such activities, which develop the student as a musician and as a person.

To (enable your child to) participate in such musical activities, you must agree to the following.

- You will be advised in advance of the times and dates of musical activities, some of which will take place outside of the scheduled Music Centre hours of operation.
- You will also be advised of any cost involved.
- In the interest of health, safety and welfare of students and staff and in keeping with good educational practice the College reserves the right to refuse participation where necessary.
